Student Engagement, Inclusion and Wellbeing

Local Excursions

Albany Rise Primary School is well situated, to enable our students to visit a wide area of our community, without the necessity for a bus or other transport. Within easy walking distance we have: schools, parks, sporting venues, shops and places of interest. As we wish to involve the students in enriching experiences while at school, teachers would like to utilise these facilities.

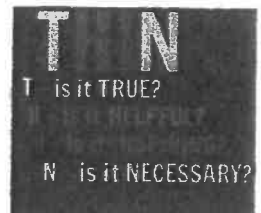
Where possible we try to give advance notice that the children are leaving school on a short walking excursion, however on some occasions an opportunity may arise when the time is too short. Please sign the attached form and return it to school.

Use Of Student Photos / Work Samples In Displays Outside Of School

From time to time the school makes use of student photos or work samples in displays inside and outside the school. This may include brochures, displays, pamphlets, handbooks, internet web pages, newspapers and DVD's. If you are happy for us to use your child's image in this way please sign, date and return this form. Only group shots of students (two or more) will be used. **Only the first name of students is printed with student displays.**

Student Use Of Internet & Email

Cybersafety is the safe and responsible use of information and Communication Technologies, such as computers, digital cameras, mobile phones and any other digital device which can be used to communicate information. At Albany Rise Primary School we think educating about cybersafety is extremely important. We also think part of the education process is ensuring that students, parents and teachers are educated about this. When it comes to cybersafety, it is important to THINK before publishing.



Students use the Internet and email at Albany Rise Primary School in a responsible manner for purposes organized by their teacher. Students are supervised at all times when they are using the Internet.

- Must obtain permission from a teacher or other supervising adult before using the internet.
- If they find unsuitable web pages they are instructed to immediately click on the home or back button and inform their teacher.
- If they receive email that is not appropriate they must immediately inform their teacher.
- They may not give out personal information such as surname, address and phone number of their parents or other students.

- They must always have their teacher's permission before publishing web pages and sending email.
- When publishing web pages and composing email messages they may only use language that is acceptable at school.
- They may not publish to the Internet using material from other web sites without permission from the person who created the material.

Breaches of the rules will see students lose Internet/email access rights for a period of time determined by their teacher and the principal.

Parents and Guardians are asked to consent to their child using the Internet at school for educational purposes in accordance with the school's guidelines, also in corresponding with others using email through the school's Internet access. The school will provide supervision and ensure that steps have been taken to minimize risk of exposure to unsuitable material.

It is important that parents discuss the importance of safety and responsible usage of computer technologies with their child/ren.

Viewing Of 'PG' Rated Media

There are specific occasions when teachers may wish to screen DVD's for students which support and enhance the classroom program. DVD's which are 'G' rated may be shown without parent consent, however, 'PG' rated videos require written authority from parents for students to view them. Further to any films being carefully chosen by staff, the teacher also previews any Internet content (such as introductory YouTube clips before presenting it to the students.

Consent to your child viewing videos in this category will assist with classroom programs and planning across the school.

Head Lice

Head lice are a perennial problem. In recent years the incidence of head lice seems to have risen everywhere. Parents are advised to make a routine inspection of their child's hair so that immediate steps can be taken should lice or eggs be present. It is important that you let us know if head lice are present, so that necessary grades can be notified and a class head lice inspection can be undertaken. Head Lice inspections will also be done each Term for all classes.

Children should remain home until appropriate treatment has been undertaken. Information from the Department of Human Services on how to treat head lice is available from the Office.

Payments for Camps, excursions/incursions, swimming program, etc.

Bookings are necessary for all events that we attend. The exact number of students attending is important for calculating costs per child which can include transport costs (buses) and any entry fee.

Ample notice is always given to parents with the due date usually set at one week prior to event. Late payments will not be accepted or processed so please be sure to return your first notice when due.

If a payment plan is needed please contact the office at the time of receiving the first notification.
