



# How to enrol at Albany Rise Primary School

## What you need to do:

1. Contact our school Albany Rise Primary School to book a school tour or to learn more about our school and the enrolment application process.
2. Download the Foundation (Prep) enrolment information pack from Enrolling in Foundation (Prep) (available from Tuesday 22 April 2025).
3. Submit an enrolment application for Foundation (Prep) by Friday 25 July 2025.
4. You will be notified of the outcome of your application by Friday 8 August 2025. If you receive an offer of placement, you should contact our school to accept the offer by Friday 22 August 2025.
5. Take part in enrolment information and transition sessions during Term 4, 2025
6. Your child will start Foundation (Prep) from Wednesday 28 January 2026.

Enrolment applications submitted after 25th July 2025 will be processed by our school as they are received, in accordance with the department's Placement Policy.

## Foundation Program

At the start of each new year, students work with teachers to establish positive practices and protocols for working in the classroom and yard with peers and adults. Students learn our Values, our Code of Conduct, our positive behaviours and our high expectations at Albany Rise. We celebrate all this learning through our special 'Quality Beginnings Celebration Morning'.

Our Foundation Program provides your child with practical and engaging learning experiences. We have a strong emphasis on Literacy and Numeracy to develop our students' reading, writing and mathematical skills. We enhance children's learning through our 'Learning through Play' program – Chatterbox. Each child will be active participants in their learning through hands-on exploration and investigation. Our program allows Literacy and Numeracy skills to develop as well as children's social, emotional and life skills.

We offer a Better Buddies Framework which helps students entering their first year of school feel safe, valued and connected to school. Each Foundation student is given a Grade 6 buddy. During the year, they will work on activities in the classroom and be a reassuring face in the yard.
