HOW TO ENROL



1. Contact our school Albany Rise Primary School to book a school tour or to learn more about our school and the enrolment application process.
2. Download the Foundation (Prep) enrolment information pack from Enrolling in Foundation (Prep) (available from Tuesday 22 April 2025).
3. Submit an enrolment application for Foundation (Prep) by Friday 25 July 2025.
4. You will be notified of the outcome of your application by Friday 8 August 2025. If you receive an offer of placement, you should contact our school to accept the offer by Friday 22 August 2025.
5. Take part in enrolment information and transition sessions during Term 4, 2025
6. Your child will start Foundation (Prep) from Wednesday 28 January 2026.

Enrolment applications submitted after 25th July 2025 will be processed by our school as they are received, in accordance with the department's Placement Policy.

We are always happy to explain the enrolment process with you, answer any questions you have and provide you with a personalised tour through our School. Families and carers are their children's first teachers. The things you do at home with your child help their learning and development and prepare them for school. The best way to support your child's learning and development is through play.

You can also support your child by doing things that help them settle in at school and feel safe, confident, and connected.



Play is the best way to help your child learn. Playing develops lifelong skills in maths, like counting, sorting, grouping and sizing. Play helps your child discover nature and science and lets them be creative. When your child plays, they are also learning about emotions and developing their language and literacy skills.



Being 'ready for school' is not about academic learning, but about understanding what school will be like and having positive expectations. To help your child settle into school we recommend participating in our *Fly in Foundation* transition to program in term four for enrolled students.
